

Naming Production Sites in SCIS

Production site names must:

- be unique within a RoP (region of production).
- be non-identifiable (no names or words). *Examples of non-identifiable names: “A”, “AA” or “A1”.*
- start with a letter.
- use only capital letters.
- not exceed 4 characters. The only exceptions to this rule are when two sites are combined e.g. AAA is combined with BBB then the new name can be a combination of the two individual names i.e. AAABBB. The only other exception is the historical convention of adding (N), (S), (E), (W) to a sub paddock e.g. AA(N).
- not use the following letters: O, I or V or a space.
- where possible continue with the use of historic production site names.

N.B. Names used for a production site can never be used for another production site within the same RoP. They may be “retired” but will remain part of the permanent record for that RoP.
